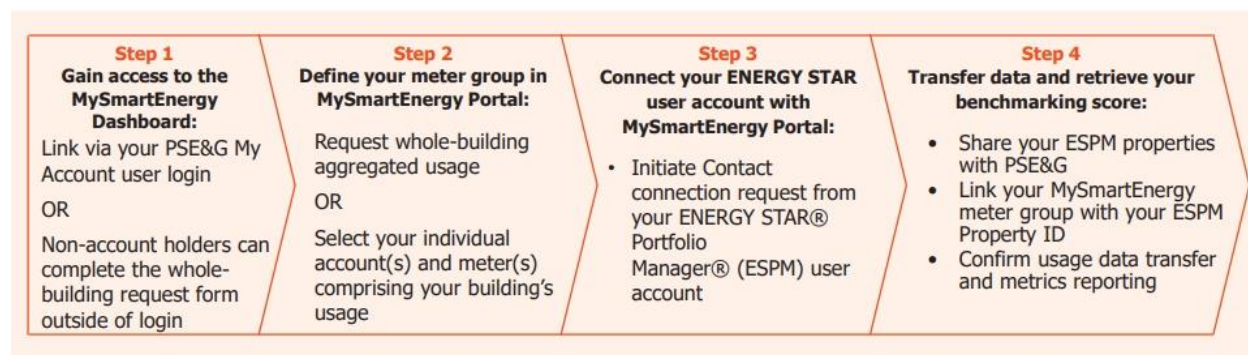

In New Jersey, Owners, or operators of commercial buildings over 25,000 square feet must comply with the NJ Clean Energy Act's Energy and Water Benchmarking Law by October 2023. This law requires tracking and reporting of energy and water usage by using the US Environmental Protection Agency's ENERGY STAR® Portfolio Manager tool.

MyMeter automates this process to make it streamlined for Owners and Operators.
